Technical information about this website's accessibility

Bourne Education Trust is committed to making its websites accessible, in accordance with the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.

Compliance status

This website is **partially compliant** with the <u>Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1</u> AA standard, due to the exemptions and non-compliances listed below.

Exemptions:

As a school we are exempt from the regulations except where the content has an essential administration function.

Non-Compliances:

- Parts of our website do not meet minimum colour contrast ratio thresholds. This fails the success criteria 1.4.3:Contrast (Minimum) (Level AA)
- Some links do not have discernible text, this fails the 4.1.2: Name, Role, Value (Level A) success criteria
- ID attributes values are not unique on the home page, this fails success criteria SC 4.1.1 Parsing.

Non-compliance with the accessibility regulations:

Disproportionate burden

 The split main navigation contains 'UL Class Elements', this fails the success criteria 1.3.1, Info and Relationships. This would be a disproportionate burden to fix as it would require a redesign of the site.

Content that's not within the scope of the accessibility regulations

- PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018 unless users need them to use a service, for example a form that lets you request school meal preferences
- Interactive Maps used for directions
- Third Party Content that is feed into our site from social media platforms such as Twitter.
