## Maths

### Learning in school:

Children will be revising their learning on inverse: that subtraction is the inverse of addition. Children will also be learning to use the inverse to find missing numbers and using the inverse to check calculations.

## Topic

### Learning in school:

**PSHE:** This week we will be talking about our favourite Mead memories in preparation for our Leavers' assembly at the end of term and road safety in preparation for our trip.

**RE:** This week, we will continue to learn about the fact that there are similarities and differences in the way people pray across different faiths.

**Art:** We will use oil pastels to colour our self-portraits and torn tissue paper to create the foliage in the background.

**History 1:** Continuing our Henry VII learning, this lesson will have a particular focus on the different types of food that were enjoyed during Tudor times, compared with what people eat in the present day.

**History 2:** In preparation for our trip, children will look at pictures from Hampton Court Palace and guess what the rooms/areas pictured are and what they were used for. Children will imagine they are travelling back in time and using that area in Tudor times, acting out what would be happening. They will then freeze frame and discuss.

**Music:** We will continue our music module for this term, which is called 'On this Island: British songs and sounds'.

**Computing:** We will continue our 'presenting ideas' module in Purple Mash.

**PE:** For this half term, we will be looking at Athletics and Invasion games.
