Learning in school:

Topic: Creepy Crawlies and Ready, Steady, Grow

This half term, we will be learning about a variety of minibeasts and looking at similarities and differences between them and where we find them. We will also be growing our own plants and vegetables.

Please can children bring in one small teddy that fits in their book bags for Friday 28th April for our music lesson.

This week our focus book is 'The very hungry caterpillar'. We will be learning some new vocabulary linked to the book-gobbled, revolting, delicious, greedy, swallow, nibble, and ingredients. We will be looking at describing the caterpillar and then using our imaginations to redesign what they would like a caterpillar to look like. We are then going to be writing sentences to describe our caterpillars.

Phonics:

This week we will be focusing on reading and writing CVCC and CCVC words, for example, champ, hunt, crack, drum. The tricky words we will be learning are 'some', 'come', 'love', 'do'.

Maths:

In maths, we will be continuing to learn numbers beyond 10, focusing on teen numbers. We will be exploring different ways to make teen numbers using numicon, cubes and bead strings.

Additional notes and reminders

This week your child will have a writing focus workbook in their book bags. This workbook is for the whole half term and the dates are shown on each page. This should be completed on a weekly basis and not all at once.

Get your child to first orally tell you a sentence about the picture and then get them to write it down. Remind your child to use their capital letters, finger spaces and full

stops and please encourage them to sound out phonetically plausible words rather than giving them the spelling.
