Learning in school:

Topic: Let's explore our planet

This half term we will learning about our planet. We will be looking at our local environment, and then comparing, and contrasting our local environment with other countries.

Following on from our farm trip, we will be writing a recount of our trip and facts we have learnt about farm animals here. Towards the end of the week, we will be learning about Australia and the animals that live there. Like when we learnt about Antarctica, we will be comparing Australia to where we live.

Phonics:

This week in Phonics, we will be revising reading and writing words ending in -er and -est. We will then be reviewing words and tricky words learnt this half term.

Maths:

This week, we will be learning about 'whole' and 'parts' and will be working on learning our number bonds of 10 off by heart.

Additional notes and reminders

Homework- We are continuing with writing this half term. Your child will be coming home with a new workbook. Just a reminder that the workbook is for the whole half term and the dates are shown on each page. This should be completed on a weekly basis and not all at once.



Get your child to first orally tell you a sentence about the picture and then get them to write it down. Remind your child to use their capital letters, finger spaces and full stops and please encourage them to sound out phonetically plausible words rather than giving them the spelling.
