Learning in school:

Topic: Let's explore our planet

This half term we will learning about our planet. We will be looking at our local environment, and then comparing, and contrasting our local environment with other countries.

This week we will be coming back from half term to find that a suitcase has been left in our classrooms. We will be describing the suitcase and drawing whom we think the suitcase belongs to. We will also be sharing part of the book 'Lost and Found' and working on the reading skill prediction.

Phonics:

This week in Phonics we will be focussing on reading and writing CVCC and CCVC words with phase 3 long vowel sounds ai ee igh oa oo oo ar or ur ow oi ear air er and Phase 2 digraphs ck sh th ch ng nk.

Maths:

This half term we will be looking at finding patterns. This week we will be exploring the resource Cuisenaire rods, putting them in order and using the rods to make up different numbers. We will also be exploring and creating out own abbc patterns for example red, green, green, blue etc.
