The Mead Infant and Nursery School Consultation on changes to Admission Arrangements 2024/25

The Mead Infant and Nursery School is consulting on our admission arrangements for 2024/25. Where the school is oversubscribed for a year group, we propose that applications for entry in 2024/25 will be ranked in the following order:

- 1. Looked after children and children who were previously looked after children.
- 2. Children with exceptional social or medical needs where it is deemed that this is the only school which can meet their needs.
- 3. Siblings children who will have a sibling in the school at the time of the child's admission.
- 4. All other children. Remaining places will be offered based on nearness to the school measured in a straight line from the address point of the child's home address, as set by Ordnance Survey, to the nearest official school gate for pupil use.

Changes proposed from the 2023/24 admission arrangements bring the policy in line with Bourne Education Trust School Admission Arrangements for 2024/25.

Our proposed 2024/25 admission arrangements are attached. Anyone wishing to participate in the consultation is encouraged to read these in detail.
