## Maths

# Learning in school:

Children will begin by revising how to partition two digit numbers into different combinations of tens and ones using part-part-whole models. We will use a blank number line to solve addition and subtraction calculations and solve word problems.

# English

## Learning in school:

We will be looking at different texts and practising answering a range of comprehension questions.

Reading - children will be read with individually this week.

SPAG - Adding 'er', 'ed', and 'est' suffix to root words ending in an 'e', bake --- baked

#### **Topic**

## Learning in school:

Geography: We will be using maps, atlases and globes to find out which countries are the hottest in the world and discovering how many countries sit on the equator

PSHE: We will be learning about personal space and boundaries.

RE: In the Christian religion, Jesus is thought to have changed people's lives. We will discuss that 'Saviour' means 'rescuer' and the story of Zaccheaeus.

Art: Children will revise hot and cold colours and experiment by mixing a range of hot colours to emulate a sunset at the African savannah.

Music: We will begin a new module for this half term which is called Zootime, to coincide with our learning about Africa.

Computing: We will introduce the children to a new module this half term: making music digitally using 2Sequence.

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at target games and sending and receiving.

#### Homework

There is no set homework for the half term break but please do continue to read with your child and please see below for the note about common exception words.

Please can you practise spelling the highlighted words at home with your child.
