Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Dangerous Dinosaurs!

We are going back in time to widen our knowledge about dinosaurs. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between the dinosaurs, their size and features. We will also be learning facts using non-fiction books and learning how to look after dinosaurs.

Theme for the Week: Let's Build!

This week we will be looking at the artist Dan Edgar who uses recyclable plastics from product containers to make sculptures. We will also be learning about different types of joins and having a go at creating our own joins in the art area.

On Tuesday 21st March, it is World Poetry Day and we will be having some fun creating our own spring poems.

Phonics:

This week we will be continuing to practise reading longer words and we will also be looking at words that have the grapheme 's' that make the sound z within words e.g. visit, poison. Maths: This week we will be learning about capacity and making salt dough. We will also be learning about time and sequencing pictures in order of what comes first, next and last. Additional notes and reminders Maths homework: the maths homework for this half term is focused around domino games. Please complete a different game each week.
