#### Maths

Learning in school:

The children will be revisiting time this week. They will begin the week by making their own clock, which they will use throughout the week to tell the time. The children will be consolidating their learning of o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to and reading 5 and 15 minute intervals.

## English/Shared reading

#### Learning in school:

The children will be researching facts about the lifecycle of a butterfly. They will be using these facts to create an information booklet all about the different stages, including pictures from each stage.

#### Reading:

We will be doing individual reads after half term so please make sure your child's book is in their book bag.

## SPAG:

Children will be learning homophones - words that have the same pronunciation but different spellings and/or meanings.

# Learning in school:

PSHE: The children will be learning about friendship and how to make 'healthy' friendship choices.

Science: The children will be finishing the topic 'Watch me Grow' and completing a mind map showing what they know now about growth and staying healthy.

RE: The children will be learning that there are similarities and differences in the way people pray.

Art: The children will be using different creative mediums to produce symmetrical art.

*Music:* We will begin our music module for this term, which is called 'On this Island: British songs and sounds'.

Computing: We will begin our 'presenting ideas' module in Purple Mash.

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at Athletics and Invasion games.
