Learning in school:

Topic: Let's explore our planet

This half term we will learning about our planet. We will be looking at our local environment, and then comparing, and contrasting our local environment with other countries.

Continuing our work on our topic book 'Lost and Found' we will be looking at similarities and differences about Antarctica and our local environment. In design and technology this week, we will be continuing to investigate boats; designing and creating our own boats and testing them in our water tray to see if they float.

We will also be discussing transition with the children and having conversations about year 1. We will be recapping zones of regulation and sharing some books to help us discuss any worries the children may have and talk about change.

Phonics:

This week in Phonics, we will be revising reading and writing words ending in -ing and - ed e.g. sleeping, floated. We will also be recapping the tricky words: some, come, love, do, I, no, go, said, have, like.

Maths:

This week, we will be learning how to share using the 'grouping' method. For example: We want to make boxes of cookies for our friends. Each box will have 4 cookies.

We have 12 cookies in total. How many boxes can we make?

Additional notes and reminders

Homework - We are continuing with writing this half term.

Your child will be coming home with a new workbook. Just a reminder that the workbook is for the whole half term and the dates are shown on each page. This should be completed on a weekly basis and not all at once.

Get your child to first orally tell you a sentence about the picture and then get them to write it down. Remind your child to use their capital letters, finger spaces and full stops and please encourage them to sound out phonetically plausible words rather than giving them the spelling.
