Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will be continuing their learning about Shape. Children will be learning to:

- Lines of symmetry on shapes
- Use lines of symmetry to complete shapes
- Sort 2-D shapes
- Count faces on 3-D shapes

Topic

Learning in school:

History: Children will be learning about Matthew Henson and his expedition.

RE: Children will be learning about worship and how do Christians give God in worship.

PSHE: Children will be learning about 'My special people'

Art: Children will continue their learning about how to use paint to explore texture and pattern.

Art: Children will learn about the Inuit artist Kenojuak Ashevak and recreating their own artwork in her style. They will begin with a pencil outline and adding colour.

Computing: Children will continue their computing module for this half term, which is called 'Creating Pictures'.

Music: Children will continue their music module for this half term, which is called 'Orchestral instruments. Theme: Traditional Western stories'.

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at Dance and Fundamentals.

Children will have song words and lines to learn for the Christmas performance. Please can children learn their song words and lines and practise these at home. Thank you.
