





# Coming up next week... 04.03.24 The timings for our new school day are: 8.30-3.05

## Maths

In Maths we will be learning to identify and represent numbers to 50 on a number line. We will be asking: 'Does a number line always start on 0?' and 'Can it be a number line if it counts in steps of 10?' The children will be learning to work out the half way point between any given start and end numbers and then we will move onto estimating a number between two given points.

### English

As it is World Book Day during the week, we will be sharing lots of favourite books and exploring open ended activities enabling us all to share our love of books. The children have loved our VIPERS text 'the Night Gardener' by the Fan Brothers and this week we will be planning our own version of the story. Last week we looked at the suffixes: -est and -er. This week we will be learning about the prefix: un and looking at how it changes the meaning of a word.

### Phonics and Reading

Our new graphemes will be: a (or) water, a (o) want, grow the code: (air) ear, ere There will be no new tricky words this week. We will be revising the words: who, whole, because, eye, people thought, through

In line with World Book day, our fluency poem this week will be: The Book Adventure. Our fluency skill will be smoothness.

#### Topic

History- In history we will be exploring the question: Did everyone live like Queen Victoria? We will be learning about rich and poor life in the Victorian era.

PSHE- We will be learning about the importance of looking after things.

Art- We will be using the skills we have learned so far this term to explore making 3D flowers.

Music- This week we will move onto learning about tempo.
