Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Dangerous Dinosaurs!

We are going back in time to widen our knowledge about dinosaurs. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between the dinosaurs, their size and features. We will also be learning facts using non-fiction books and learning how to look after dinosaurs.

Theme for the Week: Shhh, it is a surprise!

We will be having a surprise delivery, and the children will be investigating it to find out what it could be.

We will be settling the children back to the routine. This will be recapping 'What would Roo Do?' to help solve our own small social problems, revisiting the classroom rules, role playing scenarios and making suggestions on what a good choice or action would be.

Phonics:

This week we will be recapping the digraphs we have learned previously (qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk) and learning the new digraphs ai, ee and oa as well as our first trigraph igh. We will send out sounds sheet the first week back.

Maths:

This week we are recapping numbers 1 to 5 and introducing zero. We will be using rhymes and action songs to support our learning.
