Maths

In Maths we will be revisiting our learning about place value and making and recording tens and ones. The children will also be exploring 100 squares and looking at the patterns in numbers to 50. Then the children will be counting in groups of 10 and learning about multiples.

English

In English, the children will take an adventure into a special, magical garden. We will be developing descriptive word banks for us to use when we complete descriptive writing about the garden.

Phonics and Reading

Our new graphemes will be: or (ur), u and ould (short oo), are (air) au aur oor al (or)

And our new tricky words are: Once, laugh
