Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: All About Me!

During this topic we will be getting to know each other and finding out about our new friends and school.

Theme for the week: We are continuing to discuss our feelings and using the Zones of Regulation Board. We will be sharing who is special to us. We would like the children to bring in photos of the people that are special to them. These will be displayed around the classroom and the children will have the opportunity to talk about them. We will be making a class photo book.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will begin to learn the letter sounds i, n, m, d. We have introduced the words phoneme (the sound the letter makes) and grapheme (the letter written).

Maths:

For maths we will be looking at patterns and matching, similarities and differences. We will be using the stories 'Simon Sock' and 'Frog and Toad - A Lost Button' to support their learning.

Mindful Moment of the Week:

Each week we will be learning a new mindful moment. Last week we learnt about Rainbow Breathing. This week is Glitter Jar Breathing.

Additional notes and reminders

Junk Modelling: please could we ask for any plastic tubs/trays, lids, small (up to cereal box size) boxes, egg cartons, tubes etc for the children to use to create with. Please hand these to the teacher at drop off or pick up.

- Just a reminder that PE Day is on a Wednesday for all three classes. Please can your child arrive at school wearing their PE kit: blue shorts/ tracksuit bottoms (weather dependent), white t-shirt and black trainers or plimsolls (no shoelaces).
