<u>Maths</u>

Our Maths will build on the comparison work from last week and we will be comparing 2 and then 3 numbers. Then considering the order numbers are in and placing them on a number line and making our own.

English

Our text this week for Bug Club and our writing focus is: Squishy McFluff: Tea with the Queen. We too will be thinking about a way to get into the palace! What will be better... a clear labelled plan? Or a set of written instructions? What obstacles might be in our way? How will we solve the problems we may encounter?

Phonics

Next week we will be recapping the new alternative digraphs we have already covered: ay (ai), ou (ow), oy (oi), ea (ee) and reading longer words with them in and practising 'chunking'
We will also be reading and writing the tricky words: all, are, of, one, here, today. Please look out for them when sharing reading books at home and log it Boom Reader. Remember your child can change their reading book as often as you/they would like. If they have it in their hand when they come into class in the morning it serves as a good reminder. We will also do a whole class reminder every Friday.

Topic

Following on from learning about the human and physical features of Stoneleigh, we will now start looking at the key landmarks of London. If your child has been to London, it would be great if you could refresh their memory about what you did and what you saw to help with discussions in school.

In RE we will be continuing our learning about Christianity, particularly focusing on the Creation story.

In art we will be looking at abstract art, focusing on exploring colours and shapes and creating our own pictures.

PE

The children will continue to be thinking about teamwork and fitness within their PE lessons. We will be developing our understanding of how exercise helps our brain.

Homework

The children will be bringing home phonics sheets. These sheets will revise the content taught the previous week and are to help your child consolidate their phoneme knowledge.
