Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Celebrations! Everyone enjoys a celebration and there are so many across a year. We will be exploring a few to find out what is celebrated and how the occasion is marked.

Theme for the week: Diwali

We will be exploring Diwali during the week. Our music lesson will be focussed on Diwali celebration music and we will responding to music with movement and learning a different dance move a day. The children will come into school on Tuesday to a walkway of light and we will share the story of Rama and Sita. The children will be making puppets to retell the story.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will be learning the graphemes: v, w, x and y. We will continue practising blending and start to write some 3 letter words. We will be learning and reviewing the tricky words his, her, has, the, put, pull, full and and.

Maths:

This week, we will be learning all about 4 and 5. We will be deepening our understanding of numbers, subitising and looking at ways to represent 4 and 5.
