Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning on 'Addition and Subtraction', this week focusing solely on subtraction.

English

Learning in school:

In English, children will be listening to the story 'Brave and the (Arctic) Fox' and planning and writing a variation of the middle of the story.

SPAG

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

Geography: Children will be learning what it is like at the Poles, focussing on seasons and how the landscape changes.

RE: Children will be learning about Christianity and discussing the question: 'Why is giving important to Christians?'.

PSHE: Children will be focussing on their feelings and emotions and how we can all help ourselves and each other to feel happy.

Art: Children will be experimenting with mixing paints, making secondary colours.

Music: Children will continue their music module for this half term, which is called 'Orchestral instruments. Theme: Traditional Western stories.

Computing: Children will learn about Pointillist Art and how we can create this digitally.

PE: For this half term, we will be looking at Dance and Fundamentals.
