Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning on fractions:

- Find the whole

Phonics/SPAG

Learning in school:

Phonics: Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

SPAG - children will be practising their spelling, punctuation and grammar.

History: Children will be learning about who Rosa Parks was and what she is most famous for.

RE: Children will be learning about how Muslims get ready to talk to Allah and how do Muslims show that prayer is very important to them.

Science: Children will be learning about the importance of personal hygiene.

Computing: Children will continue the module on 'Questioning'.
