Today your child will revisit all the Phase 5 sounds that we have now learned and then we will be recapping all the ways to make the '(y)oo' sound that we have been looking at this week, u-e, ue and ew

Your child will be practising reading and writing words with this grapheme and applying what they have learned by writing a sentence.

Today your child will be making a poster about their likes / loves.

Ask your child how Chrissy and Annie felt about the Bog Baby in the story. Hopefully they will remember that they loved him so much. Explain to them that today they are going to have a think about the things that they love.

It might help your child if you share with them the things that you love the most. After talking about their ideas, can your child then have a go at making a poster of the things that they like / love. This could include family, friends, pets, favourite toy, favourite food, favourite activity, favourite place etc

They may like to write their name in the middle of a piece of paper and then draw all the things that they love around it. Please encourage your child to label their drawings.

Extension activity

English

Can your child write some sentences to explain why they like / love the things that they have drawn. Can they use the word 'because' in their sentences.

<u>Challenges</u>

Maths

If your child is ready for an extra challenge then they can complete the worded problems saved in the google drive. These challenges will help them to develop their reasoning and problem solving skills. If your child has just worked on o'clock times today, please just select the o'clock worded problems for them to solve.

<u>Purple Mash</u>

There are two 2Do activities set today. One is practising o'clock times and the other one is practising half past times. Your child does not have to complete both, if they have only worked on o'clock today then they could just complete that 2Do.
