Topic: Watch me grow...


This term we will be exploring growing. Our special delivery has arrived and we are watching and waiting at the moment.

Phonics

We will focus on alliteration this week by playing a game called 'Alien names'. This will encourage us to enjoy playing with words that start with the same initial sound. For example, one alien might be called 'Ping pang pop pop', 'Mig mog mully mo', or 'Fo fi fandle fee'!

<u>Keeping safe</u>
We will focus a lot of our time on remembering how to keep safe in the classroom and
