Learning in school:

We will be learning to recognise and name the different coins and notes. We will be practising counting in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's using the 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins to help us. Following on from this we will be using the coins to make up different amounts. For example how many ways can we use the coins to make the value 10p? Finally we will be adding two different prices together and finding the total.

Extra Activities

You will need lots of spare coins to do this activity:

Can your child create a small shop and make price tags for some of their toys or books. The prices can all be under 20p or 50p. Can you then be a customer and pretend to buy some of the items. Is your child able to help you choose the correct coins that total the amount needed? For example, how many different ways can they make 12p? Can they make 15p using the least number of coins? Can they add two prices together, what coins will they need to buy these items?

English

Learning in school:

In English this week we are going to be using a variety of materials to make a suitable habitat for the Bog baby from our story. We will then be writing instructions so that someone else could make one. When writing our instructions we will be thinking about having numbered steps and using bossy verbs.

Home Learning (if your child is self-isolating):

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
Activity

Can your child have a go at making something at home, this could be a lego model, a picture, an obstacle course in the garden etc. Can they then have a go at writing a set of instructions so that someone else could recreate it? Please encourage your child to give their instructions a title, create numbered steps, use bossy verbs and write in full sentences.

Phonics

Learning in school:

We will be continuing to work on Phase 5, thinking about alternative graphemes for sounds that we have already come across. This week we will be revising some alternative sounds we have looked at previously. We will be looking at the sound 'oa' being made by the split digraph 'o-e' as in phone and note, also how the sound 'oa' can be made by the digraphs 'ow' and 'oe' as in 'snow' 'grow' 'toe' and 'Joe.' Finally we will look at how the letter 'o" as in 'no' and 'go' can also be used to make the 'oa' sound.

We will be reading real and 'alien' words with these sounds and segmenting them out loud, thinking about the number of sounds in each word and then trying to write the real words. We will then be reading and writing sentences using these sounds. We will also spot the different graphemes in a longer text.

Topic

Learning in school:

In Art we will be decorating our Bog Baby that we sculpted last week using clay. When we have completed this, we will then evaluate our end product, compared to our design using our learning behaviour characters. In PSHE we will be continuing to talk about money. This week we will be finding out about the different types of jobs that we can do in order to earn money. We will also be thinking about the skills that we might need in more detail and why we might like to work towards this as a job in our future. In Computing we will continue with our unit Maze Explorers working on creating new challenges for our friends. The children will then create algorithms to solve the challenges that they have set each other. In Music we will be listening to, and appraising, a piece of music. We will also be seeing if we can identify the instruments and voices used. We will find the pulse and rhythm, and then compare this piece of music to the piece that we listened to last week. We will also find out if a story is told in this music and how it makes us feel.

In Science this week we will be dissecting flowers and learning about the different parts of a flowering plant.
