Learning in school

Suggested home learning for children self-isolating (to supplement isolation packs)

Maths

Learning in school:

This week we will continue working on numbers up to 100, comparing numbers, and ordering them. We will also be using the signs $<$, $>$ and $=$.

We will use different resources to make numbers to 100, looking carefully at how many tens and ones that they have. We will be thinking about how we can put digits in different combinations in to tens and ones places to make different numbers, for example, 14, 41, 11, 44.

We will be number detectives, finding numbers from the clues, and then writing our own maths clues for a friend.

English

Learning in school:

We will be looking at instructions and how they are set out and numbered to show the correct order. We will be using instructions within a recipe to make our own Bog baby biscuits, making sure we follow the instructions in the correct order.

Following on from this we will be, writing instructions to show how we made the biscuits so that someone else would be able to make them too. We will be numbering our instructions and using bossy verbs such as mix, drop, stir and cook to start each of our instructions as we write them.

Reading

The children can now change their book on any day of the week. They will continue to choose a new book on their reading day.

Please remember your child can still read books from the Rising Stars online reading scheme.

Home Learning (if your child is self-isolating):

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Activity

Please look at some simple recipes with your child, showing how we make cakes or biscuits.

Talk through the language that is used in the recipe. Can your child pick out the bossy verbs that are used? For example heat, put, combine, and cut.

You may like to bake some biscuits with your child and then after they are cooked, can your child write the instructions, showing what you did to make them .

Phonics

Learning in school:

We will be continuing to work on Phase 5, thinking about alternative graphemes for sounds that we have already come across. This week we will be revising some alternative sounds we have looked at previously. We will be looking at the sound 'igh' being made by the split digraph 'i-e' as in like and nine, also how the sound 'igh' can also be made by the digraph 'ie' as in tried and pie. Finally we will look at how the letter 'y' as in my and why, can also be used to make the 'igh' sound.

We will be reading real and 'alien' words with these sounds and segmenting them out loud, thinking about the number of sounds in each word and then trying to write the real words.

We will then be reading and writing sentences using these sounds. We will also spot the different graphemes in a longer text.

Topic

Learning in school:

In Art we will be sculpting our Bog Baby that we designed using clay. In RE we will be continuing to think about how to look after our planet and will be learning about the 'Three R's - reduce, reuse and recycle. In PSHE we will be continuing to talk about money and why it is important to keep money safe. We will also be thinking about why it is important to keep track of the money that you spend. In Computing we will continue with our unit Maze Explorers working on creating algorithms. In Music we will be listening and appraising a piece of music. We will be using our imagination and drawing what the music makes us think of. We will also be seeing if we can identify the instruments being played.

We will be celebrating World Music Day on Monday 21st June and each class will have a percussion workshop. We would also like to hear about if your child can play a musical instrument. If it is a manageable size they are welcome to bring it in to play for their class.
