Today your child will revisit all the Phase 5 sounds that we have now learned and then we will be looking at the digraph 'ew' making a '(y)oo' sound as in new, nephew, stew and few

Your child will be practising reading and writing words with this grapheme and applying what they have learned by writing a sentence.

Maths

Today your child will be having a go at writing some speech bubbles for the characters in our Bog Baby story.

There are some slides saved in the Google drive to support this activity. Please look through the pictures from the story on the slides and talk to your child about what is happening in the pictures and what the characters could be saying. I have added some question prompts to help them if they are a bit stuck for ideas. On the pages where there is more than one character speaking, it may help your child to do a bit of role play with you.

Can your child then choose one of the pictures from the story to write the speech bubbles for the character. They are all saved in the Google drive so you could just print the ones that your child would like to use.

Please remind your child that when they write their speech bubbles, they are writing it as if that person is talking, they won't need to use the word 'said.'

Please also remind your child to write in full sentences remembering their full stops and capital letters. They may also need to use exclamation marks and question marks today.

Time - Dates

Can your child name the months of the year? Do they know how many months there are? They may like to listen to the song on the link below.
