Maths

Learning in school:

Children will begin the week by using their place value knowledge to partition two digit numbers into different combinations of 10s and 1s. Next they will learn that subtraction is the inverse of addition and will use the inverse to check their answers to calculations are correct and also to solve missing number problems and. Finally they will practise using their number bond knowledge to solve missing number problems up to 20 without calculating the inverse.

English

Learning in school:

This week's English is all about The Enormous Crocodile by Roald Dahl. Children will be listening to and answering questions about the story. They will then consolidate their knowledge of the story by sequencing the main events of the story and acting them out in small groups. Finally they will 'story map' the story, using pictures and arrows, to show the progression of the story including identifying the setting and the main characters. They will use their story map as a visual prompt to aid verbal retelling of the story.
