We will focus on retelling stories in our own words this week by exploring Mr Gumpy's outing. Mr Gumpy goes for a journey on his boat on the river that his house is on, but lots of animals join him... and the boat gets too heavy. We will make lots of predictions about what might happen next. This will provide many opportunities for making boats, rivers and exploring numerals and number links.

We will also explore floating and sinking.

Additional notes and reminders
