## Learning in school:

Topic: Minibeasts and Growing

This next half term we will be learning about a variety of minibeasts. We will be looking at similarities and differences between them and where we find them.

This week, along with observing our caterpillars, we will link our minibeast learning to flowers and plants. We will investigate the different parts of a flower and talk about how important they are to our wildlife. We will then look at different plants and discuss where fruit and vegetables come from. Our text this week will be Supertato by Sue Hendra. We will also be starting our own growing project and will be planting some seeds.

We will ventilate the classrooms all day and spend as much time as possible outside, so please make sure your child has appropriate clothing/ sunscreen applied for sunny

days.

Home learning (for children self-isolating):

- If you don't have the book Supertato, please watch the following video and discuss how the characters might be feeling at different parts of the story and make predictions about what might happen next: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NGAy2AnzgqU</u>
- Can you write a speech bubble telling us what one of the characters in the story might be saying?
- Using recycled materials, can you design and make a trap to capture the evil peas?
- Investigate a flower: How many different parts are there? Do you know what they are called or what their purpose is? Draw, paint or collage your favourite flower.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will be recapping the digraphs: oo (long), oo(short), or and ar with a focus on spelling words with these sounds in.

Maths:

In maths, we will be learning to share out different amounts between 2 and we will be looking at whether they have been shared out equally (fairly) or not.
