Learning in school

Maths

Learning in school:

Next week in Maths we will be exploring shape. We will start off by looking at 3D shapes within our environment and move on later in the week to 2D shapes and pattern. We are looking forward to our 3D shape hunts around school!

English

Learning in school:

Next week we will be transforming an element of our whole school read, 'Shark in the Snow,' and writing our own versions. We will be thinking about sounding out, forming our letters well, using full stops and capital letters, adjectives and conjunctions.

Phonics

Learning in school:

Next week we will be revising the sounds from this term and look again at the alternate pronunciations. We will also be looking at the learning we have remembered from this term and each child will work individually with their teacher or TA to check their knowledge.

Topic

Learning in school:

In RE this week we will begin thinking about Christmas in more detail and why it is so important to Christians. We will also continue to learn our Christmas celebration songs ready to perform to you on Monday 13th December.

In Art we will be painting and decorating our clay rainforest animal models and thinking about whether there is anything that we need to change from our original design. We will also be creating some props for our Christmas celebration with you.

In Music we will be continuing to learn our Christmas songs.

In computing we will also continue to work on our keyboard skills using Purple Mash, with a focus on the bottom row keys, whilst still hovering our fingers over the home row keys.
