Maths

Learning in school:

This week in school we will be continuing our work on subtraction. We will be learning about different methods which help us find the difference and practising identifying the right resources to help us solve subtraction calculations.

English

Learning in school:

This week in school we are going to be reading our new text 'We're Roaming in the Rainforest.' We will then be looking in more detail at the animals that live in the Amazon Rainforest and doing some role play. After that the children will have a go at writing their own speech bubbles thinking about what the animals would be saying. We will continue to develop the children's use of adjectives to describe the rainforest animals as well as learning about alliteration. As in previous weeks, we will practise writing in sentences encouraging the children to use their phonic knowledge to sound out words and also remembering finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. The children will also be encouraged to write on the line using correct letter formation.

Reading

We will be introducing our new bug club story, Idris and the Big City. This story has the following key vocabulary: arm, factory, house, office, port, harbour, urban, rural, city, town, villages, hamlets

Phonics

Learning in school:

Next week we will be introducing the sounds a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e. We will be thinking about the tricky words: Mr, Mrs, Ms, ask, could, would, should and our.

Topic

Learning in school:

We will be learning about the different layers in the rainforest in Geography this week and talking about the animals that live there. In Computing we will be continuing to use Purple Mash 2type in order to learn how to touch type. In Art we will be making collages of the rainforest. In our Science work we will going on a tree hunt! This will help build the children's understanding of deciduous and evergreen trees. In PSHE we will be thinking about what makes us unique and celebrating our differences.
