Learning in school:

This week we are learning:

New GPC's: a (or) as in water, a (o) as in want, Grow the code - air (bear, there)

GPCS: or, au, oor, aur, ar, al, tch, ture, ay, u, a, aw, a-e, i-e, er, ai, o, air, are, wh, y, ear, are, ere

Tricky words: who whole because eye people thought through.

New words: ball, wall, tall, small, always, different, crocodile, celebrate, difficult, animal, again, salt, squash, swap, wasp, watch, pear, bear, wear, tear, swear.

Topic

Learning in school:

In Science this week, we will be learning about the structure and features of different birds. We will be thinking about the shape of a bird's beak and how it helps a bird to eat different types of food.

In our topic lesson the children will be thinking about what they know about space and the moon.

In Art we will be adding to our starry night pictures by using charcoal and oil pastels.

In indoor PE will be thinking about the shapes and movements our bodies can make.

In our outdoor PE sessions the children will be exploring different ways to send and receive.

In Music we will start to perform our learned song, 'Round and Round,' using our voice and instruments.

In PSHE we will be learning about what foods make up a healthy diet.

In Computing we will be continuing our learning about algorithms.
