#### Learning in school:

Next week we will be consolidating our measurement topic.

We will be recapping the language of measurement: long, short, tall, longer, shorter, taller, longest, shortest, tallest, full, empty, half full, half empty, heavy, light, heavier, lighter, heaviest, lightest, equal to, o'clock, half past, minute, hour, mass, capacity.

We will also talk about the standard units of measurement: metres, centimetres, litres, grams and kilograms.

Children will complete measurement tasks and questions and will apply what they have learnt in problem solving.
