Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Celebrations! Everyone enjoys a celebration and there are so many across a year. We will dip into a few to find out what is celebrated and how the occasion is marked.

Theme for the week: Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day

The children will be learning about why we have Bonfire Night and will be creating their own fireworks paintings in the style of the artist Jackson Pollock. They will also have the opportunity to create their own giant firework painting in the outside area. We will be also be learning a poem about fireworks noises and will be moving some of the fireworks noises around to create our own versions to share. Towards the end of the week, Reception will be learning about Remembrance Day and will have the opportunity to make their own poppy crafts.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will be learning the graphemes: v, w, x and y. Our new tricky words this week are: and, has, his, her. We will continue practising blending and writing some 3 letter words.

Maths:

This week, we will be working on counting and representing the number 4. We will also be working on our number formation.

Additional notes and reminders

Homework:

Starting the week of the 8th, we will be sending out homework on Thursdays. There will be 4 letter formations to practise each week. We recommend that your child does these at different times rather than all together and with adult support to make sure they are forming the letters correctly. On each sheet will be the letter formation that the children have learnt in school. Each week, we will collect the homework folders on Wednesdays so please ensure these are in your child's bookbag.

Reading Books:

Just a reminder to keep your child's reading book in their book bag, even if they have not finished reading it. We read with each child during the week and, therefore, need their current book.

Please check your child's Evidence Me account next week as we will be uploading their observations. You will receive an email advising that this has been done so just click on the link and it will take you to the website where you will need to log in.
