Maths

Learning in school:

This week we will be thinking about place value and extending our knowledge of numbers to fifty.

The children will practise counting accurately, writing numbers and develop their knowledge of place value.

This week we will be reading a new story, 'The start of something big.' We will look carefully at the structure of the story. This will develop into planning and writing our own versions.

Learning in school:

Next week we will be revising this half term's new phonemes and tricky words.

Topic

Learning in school:

In Science we will be considering our findings from our different investigations this half term. Using our knowledge of materials we will be designing our own kite.

In DT we will be creating our kites by looking at our designs created earlier in the week.

In RE we will be thinking about the parable, 'The Lost Sheep.' We will be discussing its teachings and what we can learn from the story.

In PE we will continue to develop our ball skills and dance skills.

In Music we will be using our learned song, 'In the Groove,' and linking it to funk music. We will be appraising 'Diggin on James Brown' by Tower of Power, and using our voices and glockenspiels to help perform the piece.

In History we will be learning about the other famous aviators within History

In Computing we will be continuing our animation story. The children will be thinking about creating a piece of text and picture. They will then use the animation tool to add movements. We will also be thinking about saving our work independently.
