<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will continue to explore and compare numbers, focusing on more and less. We will use the language 'greater than', 'less than' and 'equals' and we will introduce the children to the symbols \leftrightarrow =

English

This week the children will be thinking about what it means to be part of The Mead family and why we are proud to belong. We will be thinking about what they like about The Mead and who helps them at school.

We will practise writing in sentences encouraging the children to use their phonic knowledge to sound out words and also remembering finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. The children will also be encouraged to write on the line using correct letter formation.

Reading Books

Next week we will be moving to whole class reads. Please continue to read as much as possible at home. The children can change books as many times as they need.

Please remember that at The Mead we encourage the children to read to you at least four times each week as they really benefit from practising their reading regularly at home. ©

Phonics sounds

Next week we will be recapping phase 4 sounds and practising reading and writing CVCC CCVC and CCVCC words using the sounds already learnt.

Topic

Our topic for this half term will be 'Proud to Belong.' In Art this week they will be designing a new school logo or badge. In RE we will begin reading some stories from the Bible beginning with Jonah and the whale. In PSHE we will be recapping 'What would Roo do? Thinking about making good choices outside. In computing we will continue to practise using the chrome books.

PE

The children will have daily PE sessions outside. They will not yet get changed for these sessions but please make sure that your child is able to get dressed and undressed independently. Every Tuesday the children will also have a yoga session so they will need to be able to take their shoes off and put them back on independently.

The children will have their PE lesson outside, so please could you provide them with some jogging bottoms to keep in their PE bags for when it is cold.
