Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: *All about me!*

During this topic we will be getting to know each other and finding out about our new friends and school.

Theme for the week: This week we will be having a bursting table in the classroom. Each day 6 children will be invited to bring one thing in from home that is special to them. **A slip will come home each day to invite specific children to share.** The children can put their special item on the bursting table and can talk to their friends about it. Please can you help your child select something that they will be able to talk about and that reflects their interests as we will be using these items to help us with future planning. By the end of the week each child will have been invited to share a special item.

As part of our 'All about me' topic we will be exploring 'Belonging' in RE. We will be talking about special places in the community and would love some photos of any religious buildings you and your family visit so we can personalise the lesson and make it directly relevant to our children. Please email any photos you are happy to share with your child's class to the class teacher.(see email address below)

Phonics: This week we will begin to learn the letter sounds m, n, i and d.

This week, your child will come home with a sounds folder for you to keep at home. Weekly, we will send home the sounds we have learnt during the week. We ask that you put this sheet into their sounds

folders to keep them together. Please can you practise making the sounds with your child.

Maths: We will be comparing amounts using the words more and fewer and comparing the height of objects (taller and shorter) and length of objects (longer and shorter).
