Learning in school:

Learning in school:

During the first week back we will begin our new topic, 'tumbling back through time.' Within English we will be using the book, Alice in Wonderland to develop our writing. We will start by imagining what Alice could see, hear, touch and smell as she fell down the rabbit hole. Within our writing we will continue to consolidate the use of capital letters, full stops, conjunctions and adjectives.

Topic

Learning in school:

Our new topic, 'Tumbling back in time,' will be our focus this term.

In PSHE we will be thinking about people who keep us safe and their different roles.

In Computing we will begin our coding unit.

In our PE sessions the children will be starting units on striking and fielding and athletics.

In History we will be learning about the life of Queen Victoria and learning facts about her life.

In Art we will be thinking about the Victorian artist William Morris and his designs. The children will be thinking about, and creating their own designs.
