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Coming up next week...21.11.22

Maths

This week we will be revisiting the vocabulary part and whole. We will be using this knowledge to introduce the concept within subtraction. We will be using number bonds within 10 to solve subtraction calculations and worded problems.

English

This week we are going to be retelling our story, 'Lost in The Toy Museum.' We will be story mapping as a group and then retelling the beginning using our own sentences. Children will be focussing upon, capital letters, full stops, adjectives, conjunctions.

Phonics

Next week we will be introducing the sounds **a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e**. We will be thinking about the tricky words: **Mr, Mrs, Ms, ask, could, would, should** and **our**.

Topic

History - In History we will be thinking about how toys have changed over time and what significance this has.

Music - In Music we will be thinking about pulse, pitch and melody,

Science - In Science we will be continuing our learning on materials and thinking about properties.

PE - In PE we will be continuing our topics Ball Skills and Fundamentals. In Fundamentals we will be thinking about dodging and changing direction. In Ball Skills we will be thinking about throwing with aim, at targets.
