<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will continue to explore and compare numbers, focusing on one more. We will use the language 'greater than', 'less than' and 'equals' and ask the children to represent their numbers through writing.

<u>English</u>

This week we are continuing to look a sentence writing. We will be thinking about using full stops, capital letters, fingers spaces and question marks.

Reading Books

Next week we will be moving to Bug Club whole class reads. Please continue to read as much as possible at home. The children can change books as many times as they need. Please remember that at The Mead we encourage the children to read to you at least four times each week as they really benefit from practising their reading regularly at home. ©

Phonics sounds

Next week we will be recapping phase 4 sounds and practising reading and writing CVCC CCVC and CCVCC words using the sounds already learnt.

<u>Topic</u>

In History we will be thinking about timelines and learning about past, present and future. In PSHE we will be recapping 'What would Roo do? Thinking about making good choices outside. In music we will be using instruments to help perform a song.

PE

This term the children will be thinking about teamwork and fitness within their lessons.

<u>Homework</u>

This week each child will bring home a set of phonics sheets. These sheets match the content taught within the week and are to help your child consolidate their phoneme knowledge.

The set covers the whole half term and does not need to be returned. Please revise one sheet a week, by reading with your child each of the phonemes. Please continue to listen to your child read four times a week, and log it on Boom Read.

History timeline project **(To be completed over the next 4 weeks)** - As we are learning about timelines this week, we would like your child to create a timeline of events from their own lives using pictures from their past and present. This is a piece of work that will not be expected until the end of the half term, but please talk to your child about how they would like to create their timeline. We will give further information regarding homework in our year 1 meeting on the 22nd
