Maths

Learning in school:

This week in school we will be thinking about number bonds to ten and how to systematically approach problem solving. We will be introducing tens frames and using addition to demonstrate different calculations to ten.

English

Learning in school:

This week in school we are going to be introducing our new topic Toys. The children will be listening to a new text and retelling the story as a group. They will then work together to write words and phrases which will help us develop our own versions.

In RE/ICT we will be thinking about Diwali and discussing key features of the celebration. This will link to our computing, in which we will be creating our own Rangoli patterns. In PE we will be starting our new topics of fundamentals.

In Music the children will be continuing their learning about rhythm and pitch.
