Every year we offer the children the opportunity to design their own Christmas cards at home with you. 1. Purchase your pack online. <u>https://www.pta-events.co.uk/themeadpa</u>

If you submit artwork without purchasing a pack we will be unable to get it printed. Each pack has 12 cards. The first pack is £6 per pack and any subsequent packs (of the same artwork) are £5. If you have two children and you want two packs of artwork for each child, you need to purchase 2 First Packs and 2 Additional Packs.

- 2. Design your child's artwork on the printed template following the guidelines below.
  - Keep within the lines of the template, using the middle and keeping away from the corners to give the best result.
  - Use brightly coloured felt pens or paints (if the paint is messy, the print will be messy too!)
  - <u>No</u> stickers, cotton wool, glitter, metallic pens, wax crayons or pencils please.
  - If you prefer, you can draw an outline for your child to colour in.
  - Keep the template as flat as possible.
  - Please print the details on the template as clearly as possible to make reading the child's name easy. We cannot be held responsible for mistakes in the spelling of the children's names if the forms are not clearly printed.
- 3. Return your design with your child's name and class details on the template to one of the marked boxes in the playground. These boxes will be in the playground on the morning and afternoons on Monday 7th, Tuesday 8th and Wednesday 9th November. Wednesday 9th November is the deadline. If your child is at ChillOut, we will collect from ChillOut. Please do not put the designs in bookbags as these will not be collected.
