Maths

Learning in school:

In Maths this week we will be comparing numbers by looking at the terms greater than, less than and equal to.

We will be exploring what these terms mean and looking at concrete representations within our environment and matching numbers and words to groups of objects.

English

Learning in school:

In English this week, we will be continuing to think about adjectives. We will be writing sentences linked to the text, 'The Dot.'

Phonics

Learning in school:

We will continue recapping the sounds (er, oo, oo, ai, ee, igh, ay, ou, oy, ee, ea, ear,air). The children will be practising reading and writing words using these sounds. We will also continue to practise reading the tricky words - all, are, I, of, one, here, today

Reading

Next week we will be starting a new whole class read, 'Adventure through the Ages.' We will be introducing the following vocabulary – archaeologist, prehistory, artefacts, written records, historical source, Stone age, Bronze age, Iron age, hunter-gatherer, nomadic and shield.

Topic

Learning in school:

This week we will be learning about the weather in the UK and looking at weather symbols. We will then be creating weather maps and having a go at our own forecasts.

In Art we will continue to explore what happens when we mix different colours together. We will also be learning about how to use oil pastels to create different effects.

In RE we will be considering what Christians believe about God.

In computing we will continue to practise using the chrome books and will complete an art activity on Purple Mash

In PE we will continue with our 'Fitness' and 'Team Building' topic the children will also attend their weekly yoga sessions. Please ensure that on Tuesdays the children wear socks and if wearing a skirt, shorts are worn underneath.
