

## Level 1 – Home learning plan in the event of individual children self-isolating

- A **'Get Going' home learning pack** will be available to download for each year group on the school website. You will find this information under **Parents/Home Learning**
- The pack will include a range of activities across all curriculum areas for children to work on independently. There will be paper copies available for families who do not have internet or printer access. These will be able to be collected from a box at the main entrance on Cuddington Avenue by a member of your family / friend who is not isolating. Please inform your class teacher if you will require a printed pack.
- There will also be **'Level 1 home learning ideas'** on our weekly 'Coming Up Next Week' parent mail. These will link to what the children will be learning in class
- You will also have access to the on-line reading scheme. We will be sending you a new password to access this
- Parents will also have contact with the class teacher via the **class email address**. For children who are self-isolating for two weeks, class teachers will phone the parents to check in half way through the self-isolation period. Class teachers will also contact vulnerable families who are self-isolating for a shorter period of time.
- Children currently receiving in school gross motor or fine motor interventions will receive individual support packs from our SEND TA. Packs will also be available on the website under Parents/Home Learning
- Our school SENCo Mrs Bedford and our Teacher of the Deaf Mrs Temko will be in contact with families of children who have EHCP's
- In the event of the Class Teacher having to self-isolate for 2 weeks and they are able to work. The teacher will have daily contact with the class at school through TEAMS

## Level 2 - Home learning plan in the event of whole classes/ year groups having to isolate for 2 weeks or wider whole school closure

- **Daily home learning** will be emailed out via parent mail (starting on day 2 of closure). Day 1 of closure children should use the **'Get Going' home learning pack**.
- It will include the following daily activities:

### **For EYFS**

- 1 Phonics/ Communication & Language/ Literacy activity
- 1 Maths activity
- 1 Topic activity
- 10 minutes reading a day

### **KS1**

- 1 Phonics activity
- 1 English activity
- 1 Maths activity
- 1 Topic activity
- 10 minutes reading a day

*These will include lessons being taught via the Oaks Academy where appropriate*

### ➤ **Additional support and activities**

2Do's set on Purple Mash

A short 5 minute daily recorded video by the teacher uploaded on the class Purple Mash blog which supports an element of the day's teaching, this may also include stories and videos from support staff within the class. The children will be taught how to access Purple Mash, how to find the 2Do's and videos during their computing lessons at school

- Parents will also have contact with the class teacher via the **class email address**. The class teacher will also arrange an up to 5 minute **"Keeping in Touch"** zoom call with the parents to check in over the course of the two-week isolation period. The child may attend if it is appropriate. This will continue if the whole school is closed for an extended period of time
- Our school SENCo Mrs Bedford and our Teacher of the Deaf Mrs Temko will be in contact with families of children who have EHCP's

**If the class teacher is unable to work for some part of the isolation or all of the isolation period the children will need to revert to the Level 1 home learning plan**
