Maths

Learning in school:

Children will begin the week recapping on counting in 2, 5 and 10s from zero they will be linking this knowledge to multiplication to be able to solve problems in an array. Next they will revisit what a multiplication calculation looks like and how they solve these calculations. They will practice how to show jottings to help them answer a multiplication question. Finally they will solve multiplication worded problems. We will look at reading the question and underlining the important parts!
