Learning in school:

Topic: Watch me grow...

This week we have been busy planting broad beans. We will be watering these and watching them grow over the next few weeks.

Seeds

We will be examining, sorting and investigating many different seeds this week. We will use lots of mathematical language associated with size, shape and interesting features. This will also link with noticing features of our environment and the word around us. We will plant one of each type of seed to see what happens for the rest of the term.

Eid

We hope everyone who celebrated Eid last Thursday had a good time! We will be exploring this in more detail on Monday when the children are back in school. Please send in anything related to Eid if you did celebrate it- photos, artefacts, books, etc. We will be making Eid biscuits with the children.

Phonics


We will enjoy a game called 'cross the river' where the children can only cross the river to the other side if they can blend our sounds into CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words. E.g. C.A.T blends into cat. Be careful to only use soft sound like in the clip below.

We will ventilate the classrooms all day and spend as much time as possible outside, so please make sure your child has appropriate clothing, and maybe even remember how take off, and put on their coats!
