English/ History

Learning in school:

This week we will be learning about Sir Francis Drake and the fact that he was a Tudor who sailed around the world in a single journey from 1577-1580. We will be writing a fact file about him and Scott of the Antarctic (who we learned about during our Come and Explore with Me topic) and making comparisons between these two historically significant people.

Reading:

We will be reading individually with the children this week.

PSHE: This week, we will be learning about road safety.

DT: Children will be making their own pop-up books over the next couple of weeks. First, they will look at a variety of pop-up books and look at their various mechanisms: spring, slider, pop out etc. Children will thought shower different themes that they might base their pop-up book around and then choose one. They will plan their book, then make the pop-out, spring and slider pages of their books. Art: Children will add colour to their Frida Kahlo-style self-portraits using oil pastels.

Music: Children will continue to 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' focusing on classical music and learn songs for our Leavers' assembly.

Inside PE: We will continue our Invasion Games module, using a variety of skills to score goals.

Outside PE: We will continue our Athletics module, developing the sprinting action.

Computing: We will begin a new module: Presenting a Story. Children will explore how a story can be presented in different ways. They will examine a traditional tale presented as a mind map, as a quiz, as an e-book and as a fact file. Children will learn that digital content can be represented in many forms.

Homework

If you have any pop-up books at home, it would be great if your child could please bring one into school to show the class. We will be sharing our books and getting ideas for our own pop-up books during our DT lessons this coming week.

Also, next week we will be continuing our focus on Common Exception Words by asking the children to spell some more tricky words within sentences. Below are the words that we will be asking the children to write each day and we would love it if they could please practise these over the weekend.
