# Learning in school:

Topic: Big Wide World

This next half term we will be learning about the world. We will be looking at our local environment, transport, maps and countries around the world.

This week we will be focussing on The Queen's Jubilee and the story "The Queen's Hat". We will be using this to learn about the life of the Queen, our local area, reading and drawing maps, and looking at London and it's landmarks. We will also be making crowns for the school picnic on Friday and practising our songs to share with parents during the opening of the Jubilee Garden.

We will ventilate the classrooms all day and spend as much time as possible outside, so please make sure your child has appropriate clothing/ sunscreen applied and sunhats for sunny days.

## Phonics:

This week in Phonics we will be focussing on reading and writing words with long vowel sounds. These are: ai ee igh oa oo oo ar or ur ow oi ear air er ck sh th ch ng nk. Please also practise tricky words with your child. This helps with their reading. Attached is a tricky word sheet.

## Maths:

In Maths we will be looking at fractions. The children will be learning about whole and not whole and will be introduced to the vocabulary: 'whole' and 'part'. We will be using the stem sentences:

"This is a whole.... because I have all of it."

"This is not a whole ..... because I don't have all of it."

Use can support your child's learning by talking to them while cutting an eg apple and using the stem sentences and letting them tell you if it is a whole or not a whole.
