Topic

Learning in school:

In Science we will be investigating different materials that are rigid and flexible.

In Art we will be adding details to the landscape picture we created earlier this week in the style of Natalie Rymer.

In PSHE we will be thinking about road safety and role playing how to cross the road safely. We will also be creating road safety posters.

In RE we will be reading the new parable, 'The Wise Man and The Foolish Man' and thinking about the morals and teaching of this story.

In PE we will continue to develop our ball skills and dance skills.

In Music we will be using our learned song, 'In the Groove,' and linking it to folk music. We will be appraising 'Lord of the Dance' taken from River dance and using our voices and glockenspiels to help perform the piece.

In History we will be learning about the Wright brothers and the history of the aeroplane.

In Computing we will be starting an animation unit of work.
