Maths

Learning in school:

This week in maths, we will be continuing to work on fluency with regard to calculations for the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be continuing to practice finding fractions of a number. Additionally we will be recapping 3D shapes and the mathematical language used to describe their properties. Children will be challenged by comparing 3D shapes and describing their similarities and differences.

English/ Reading

Learning in school:

This week, we will write our own version of The Enormous Crocodile. Children will use their plans to write a story in which they have come up with a new trick that the crocodile has devised. This piece of work will be independent with the purpose of the children showing off everything that they have learned in Year 2 with regard to punctuation and composition. When children have finished their story, we will recap how to edit and improve one's own writing.

Reading:

We will be reading with children individually again this week.

Topic

Learning in school:

PSHE: This week, we will talk about sleep and its importance in helping us feel in the 'green zone' (ready to learn). Children will thought-shower ideas of what we can do to help us get enough sleep and then create a poster.

Science: Firstly, we will check on our beans to see if they have grown at all yet. We will record any changes we see on our results sheet. Secondly we will learn about the stages of the frog life cycle. Children will draw and label their own frog life cycle, linking the different stages together.

RE: In RE this week, we will continue our topic of Islam, focusing on Muhammed (pbuh). We will share the Qu'ran with the class, explaining the importance of washing our hands first and placing it up high when it is not being used.

Art: Children will learn about Escher and his artwork 'Fish and Frogs'. We will discuss tessellation and the use of monochrome colour. Children will create their own printing blocks from layers of cardboard/foam which they will use next week to create an Escher-style masterpiece.

Inside PE: In gymnastics, children will develop rolling and build sequences.

Outside PE: We will continue our Striking and Fielding module, where this week children will develop striking for distance and accuracy.

Music: Children will continue to learn the Friendship Song by Joanna Mangona, whilst also listening to and appraising the song 'You Give a Little Love' from Buggy Malone. We will discuss the tempo, dynamics and texture of the songs, comparing and contrasting them.

Computing: This week, children will continue the 'Creating Pictures' module, learning about Surrealism and eCollage using 2PaintaPicture on Purple Mash.
