Learning in school:

On 22.2.22 we will be participating in Twosday activities. In Maths we will be using our addition knowledge and thinking about different ways to make numbers by adding two numbers together.

Topic

Learning in school:

This term we will be introducing our new topic, 'To infinity and Beyond.' To start our topic the children will be considering what they already know and what they would like to learn about.

In PE we will starting our new modules. Indoor PE will be gymnastics. In our outdoor PE sessions the children will be learning about sending and receiving within games.

In Music we will be starting a new piece, 'Round and Round. In week 1 the children will listen to a piece of music and consider the rhythm and beat.

In PSHE we will be thinking about how to stay safe near water.

In our RE lessons we are continuing to look at Christianity. We will be thinking about why Jesus told parables.

In Computing we will be starting a new unit of learning in which the children will learn about algorithms. We will be thinking about giving instructions clearly to achieve an outcome.
