#### Maths

We will be learning to recognise and name the different coins and notes. We will be practising counting in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's using the 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins to help us. Following on from this we will be using the coins to make up different amounts. For example how many ways can we use the coins to make the value 10p? Finally we will be adding two different prices together and finding the total.

# **English**

In English this week we are going to be recounting our Geography walk to Stoneleigh. We will also be thinking about this term's book and recounting the order of events.

In our recount writing we will be thinking about time conjunctions such as first, then, after that. We will also be thinking carefully about our sentence structure.

#### Reading

Music -In music we will be listening to, and appraising, our favourite pieces of music from this year. We will also be seeing if we can identify the instruments and voices used. We will find the pulse and rhythm, and then compare this piece of music to the piece that we listened to last week. We will also find out if a story is told in this music and how it makes us feel.

Science - In science this week we will be identifying different types of trees.

Geography - In geography we will be thinking about the features of the seaside and labelling seaside pictures.

PE - In PE we will continuing with our target practise and invasion units of study.
